**Women's Voices in Politics**

*This workshop will focus on learning how to run a campaign, manage ethical dilemmas, work with the media, and be involved in governance. It will also address issues and challenges related to being involved in politics; financing your political endeavors, and brainstorming ideas to help overcome barriers.*

**Women in Business**

*This workshop will be run by Pauktuutit, the Inuit Women of Canada organization. They have created specific programming around business development that supports Inuit women in starting their own business. They have published the "Journey to Success: an Aboriginal Women's Business Planning Guide" and have conducted similar workshops in Nunavut in previous years.*

**Women's Personal Growth and Development**

*This workshop will focus on personal experiences and what it takes to be a leader; it will focus on finding and creating your own voice, explore goals and aspirations and touch upon areas of health and wellness with a*

traditional focus.

**Traditional Leadership**

*. This workshop will focus on traditional styles of leadership within an Inuit cultural perspective and the woman's role in teaching and passing along Inuit knowledge and skills, along with a holistic perspective on health, family wellness and building a balanced life.*

**Community Leadership Development**

*This workshop will address women's leadership on the community level and focus on learning how to write proposals; understanding the structure of local boards and councils; and learning how to host your own workshops, sewing circles, etc. This will be facilitated by various Inuit women's groups from Nunavut.*

**Women's Human Rights**

*This workshop will facilitate discussions about how women in Nunavut can use national and international human rights laws to help them in their work and communities to advance the human rights of women. Issues of concern to women in Nunavut will be discussed and examples will be used to show how 'knowing your rights' can help women carry their voices to the territorial, national and even international level.
