### **G7 Meeting will be Held in Nunavut**

**Run dates: *February 1-4, 2010***

**IQALUIT, Nunavut (February 1, 2010)** - This week, Finance Ministers and Central Bank Governors from Canada, the United States, the United Kingdom, France, Germany, Italy and Japan will meet in Iqaluit, Nunavut. This meeting is also known as the group of seven, or the G7.

The Ministers and Governors will discuss financial sector reforms, strengthening banks and other financial institutions, and the economy.

Canada's Minister of Finance, the Honourable Jim Flaherty, and Canada's Minister of Health, the Honourable Leona Aglukkaq, chose Nunavut as the location of the meeting to showcase the pristine beauty of the North and to encourage a comfortable, open discussion on important international issues.

The meeting occurs on Friday, February 5<sup>th</sup> and Saturday, February 6<sup>th</sup>. This week, residents of Iqaluit may notice more international visitors, journalists, security and traffic. All roads will remain open.
