A challenging and rewarding position awaits an individual who is interested in working as a community counselor within a school environment. Under the supervision of the Principal, you will be responsible for acting as a liaison between the student, the home, the school and the community. This position promotes the relevance of education for future lifestyles, not only for the students but also for the entire community.

The School Community Counselor (SCC) is responsibly for providing counseling and guidance to the students. The SCC will function as a member of the school staff in areas of public relations in cooperation with the administrative and teaching staff. The SCC will record all home visits, student consultations and prepare all necessary documentation according to school procedures and education policies in Nunavut. The SCC will work towards the promotion of parental involvement in their child's development, especially in school related matters.

The successful candidate should have five or more years experience counseling and working with children and youth at a community level. The ability to be bilingual in both Inuktitut and English would be an asset. Training such as the Human Services Program at Arctic College is desired. The successful candidate must be willing to participate in further training as it becomes available.

Equivalencies that consist of a combination of education, knowledge, skills and abilities to formal education and experience requirements will be considered

This position is included in the Nunavut Employees Union and has a starting hourly rate of \$31.43 per hour, plus an annual Nunavut Northern Allowance of \$14.60 and a Bilingual Bonus of \$1,500 per annum.
