The Department of Health and Social Services, Qikiqtaaluk Region is looking for an individual who would like to help make a difference in Nunavut.

Reporting to the Director of Social Programs, the incumbent should provide an integrated system of programs and support which residents of the Baffin communities have confidence in and which are delivered in reliable and professional manner and which enhance the social status of the population. This is senior level practitioner position that has responsibility for managing and providing direct supervision to social workers at various levels of qualification, experience and training as well as the supervision of support staff. The incumbent ensures compliance with professional standards, protocols and best practices and supports the enhancement of appropriate linkages with staff as well as allied agencies and community organizations. Program delivery occurs in the community of Pond Inlet and Arctic Bay, which has a combined population of 2000+. Operating within a defined budget the incumbent is required to use sound judgment in allowing funds in the most appropriate manner.

The incumbent is required to have a Bachelor Degree in Social Work with three years directly related field experience, including proven supervisory experience or a Master's Degree with one year related experience to include proven supervisory experience. Experience also includes assisting, assessing, interviewing, counseling and facilitating. The incumbent is required to keep up to date with current social work practices. This position also requires a minimum of 2 years of child protection.

Equivalencies that consist of a combination of education, knowledge, skills and abilities to formal education and experience requirements will be considered

This position is included in the Nunavut Employees Union with a salary of \$87,224.00, plus a Northern Living Allowance of \$24,214.00 per annum.
