The incumbent develops goals and objectives, plans and organizes services, directs a skilled and knowledgeable team and evaluates service delivery for the Diagnostic Imaging Department in accordance with the vision, values and business plans of QGH and the Department of Health and Social Services (DHSS). The incumbent performs professional diagnostic imaging services upon referral from the medical staff in accordance with the standards and practices of the professional governing body.

The incumbent must:

- Be either a Medical Radiological Technologist or an Ultrasonographer and must be a current registered member in good standing with the CAMRT (Canadian Association of Medical Radiological Technology) and/or CSDMS (Canadian Society of Diagnostic Medical Sonographers) and/or CARDUP (Canadian Association of Registered Diagnostic Ultrasound Professionals) and/or ARDMS (American Registry of Diagnostic Medical Sonographers). A dual trained professional would be considered an asset.
- Successful completion of an accredited Medical Radiological Technology or Sonography program.
- Possess the management/leadership skills and knowledge necessary to establish a positive professional team environment. Ideally, the incumbent will possess three years of management related experience.
- Possess knowledge of ECG, Holter Monitor and Cardiac Event Recorder Studies.
- Have annual certification in CPR and WHMIS.

Knowledge of Inuit language, communities, culture, land and Inuit Qaujimagatuqangit is an asset. Equivalencies that consist of a combination of education, knowledge, skills and abilities to formal education and experience requirements will be considered.
