**CONSOLIDATION OF
BREWERY REGULATIONS**

R-005-93

AS AMENDED BY

This consolidation is not an official statement of the law. It is an office consolidation prepared for convenience of reference only. The authoritative text of regulations can be ascertained from the *Revised Regulations of the Northwest Territories, 1990* and the monthly publication of Part II of the *Northwest Territories Gazette* (for regulations made before April 1, 1999) and Part II of the *Nunavut Gazette* (for regulations made on or after April 1, 1999).

Liquor Act (Nunavut)

Brewery Regulations

The Commissioner, on the recommendation of the Minister, under section 54 of the *Liquor Act* and every enabling power, makes the *Brewery Regulations*.

1 A person may apply for the issue or renewal of a brewery permit by submitting an Application for Brewery Permit in the form set out in the Schedule.

2 The Board shall not issue a brewery permit to an applicant who has, within the five years preceding the day application is made for the issue of a brewery permit, been convicted of an offence referred to in paragraphs 10(a), (b) or (c) of the Liquor Regulations.

3 The holder of a brewery permit shall, at the request of the Board and in a form acceptable to the Board, provide returns or reports respecting

- (a) the quantity of beer produced at a brewery operated under the brewery permit; and
- (b) the sale or other disposition of beer produced at the brewery.

4(1) The fee for the issue of a brewery permit is \$500.

(2) The fee for the renewal of a brewery permit is \$500.
