
PREVENT THE SPREAD OF AVIAN INFLUENZA IN WILD BIRDS

Follow these tips to stop the spread:

SPOT AND REPORT the signs of avian influenza.

Report a sick or dead bird to your local Conservation Officer.



DO NOT TOUCH SICK BIRDS or feed wild birds by hand.

If you are a hunter or bird bander, always follow safe handling practices.



REDUCE THE RISK

with safe handling practices.

Reduce risk by wearing gloves, washing hands with warm soapy water, clean clothing and equipment after contact.



COOK WELL game birds and their eggs.

It is considered safe to hunt and handle healthy game birds and consume fully-cooked game birds and their eggs.
