

Within Nunavut, lottery licencing is administered by the Consumer Affairs Office of the Department of Community and Government Services.

Please follow the recommended steps if you are seeking a lottery licence:

Eligibility Criteria

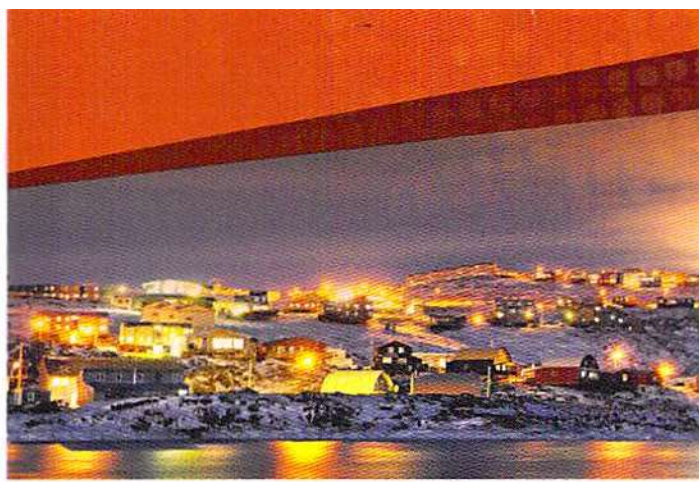
Only charities and religious organizations are eligible for a lottery licence. Organizations must be registered under the Societies Act or the Income Tax Act.

Required Documentation

Organizations must submit the following documentation as part of an application package:

1. Application Form.
2. List of Executive Form.
3. House Rules.
4. Societal Status Certificate or letter of support.
5. Licence Fee Payment.

Submission Timelines

Please submit your application 30 days before the start of the licenced event. For example, if your event is scheduled to start on September 1, submit all the required documents by August 1 or before.

Consumer Affairs charges a late fee of \$100.00 for applications that need to be processed sooner than 30 days.

Paying the Licence Fee

Payments can be made by cheque, money order or credit card.

Credit card payments are recommended to reduce processing time. If you choose to pay by credit card, a form will be provided to you to fill out. Processing credit card payments can take up to 3-5 business days.

Cheques and money orders can be made payable to the Government of Nunavut and mailed to the Consumer Affairs Office.

Consumer Affairs provides the following support to Nunavummiut:

- ▶ **Lottery licence administration:** Bingo; Nevada Pull Tickets; Raffle Tickets (Local); Raffle Tickets (Territorial Wide); 50/50 Coupon Tickets; Casino; Sports Draft; and Texas Hold'Em Poker.

- ▶ **Business licence administration.**
- ▶ **Consumer Protection Services.**





Organizations seeking to raise funds through a lottery, must apply for lottery licence with the Consumer Affairs Office in Baker Lake.
