What is SSEEP?

The Summer Student Employment Equity Program (SSEEP) provides an opportunity for students attending school, college or university to obtain employment during the summer break.

SSEEP is designed to provide Nunavummiut students with meaningful work experience or training within the Nunavut Public Service. SSEEP runs from April through September.

What's the outcome?

You will gain new experience, knowledge and skills working for different GN departments.



It will open your eyes to new or existing possibilities.

It will aid in the financing of your education and living expenses.

Your supervisor will be your reference so punctuality is highly valued.

How are applications reviewed?

Applications are reviewed on a first come first served basis.

Applications are compared with positions by their area of study, when there is no position comparable to the current studies **you** will be assigned a position based on other experiences.

How do I apply?

To apply for the SSEEP you have to fill out an application form, attach a resume and submit it to the Department of Finance. Proof of enrollment in school is also required.

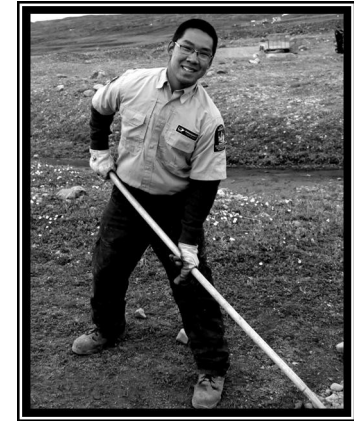

Who is eligible?

If you are a student who will be returning to school in the fall and interested in gaining work experience with the Government of Nunavut, we encourage you to submit your application for consideration.

In order to be eligible for the program, a Nunavut student must be enrolled in a high school program (grade 10, 11 or 12) or a post-secondary program with a designated college, university or other institute for the following term or semester.



What should be included in your application:

- A filled out SSEEP application form included in the information package.
- Your most current resume.
- Proof of acceptance from an institution or high school schedule.
- When you are available to start.
- You may be asked to provide proof of residency.
- References/criminal record checks may be required, and are considered an asset.
