The Board is an advisory group that provides strategic direction and recommendations to the Minister of Family Services on matters relating to apprenticeship, trade and occupations, and receives and reviews appeals under the *Apprenticeship Act*.

Board members must have current, pertinent knowledge and direct experience in trades and industry developments in Nunavut, and/or be an active journeyman in one of the Nunavut designated trades, with no less than five years of experience after obtaining trade certification.
