## Topic: Population Age Group Distribution and Average Age

2011 and 2016 Censuses
Released by Statistics Canada, May 3, 2017
Background: $\quad$ According to the 2016 Census, the average age in Nunavut was 27.7 years, which is the lowest in the country. The territory had the highest proportion of children aged 14 and under at $32.5 \%$ and the lowest proportion of people aged 65 and over at $3.8 \%$.

The proportion of people aged 65 and over increased between 2011 and 2016 for all the provinces and territories, while the percentage of children aged 14 and under declined.
