## Business Licence Renewal

The Department of Community and Government Services Consumer Affairs Section is now accepting business licence renewal applications for the 2023-2024 fiscal year.

Businesses such as a profession, trade, manufacture or undertaking that operate outside of municipal boundaries or conduct business throughout Nunavut must apply for a licence from the Consumer Affairs Section.

Applicants may find the business licence renewal package from the [Consumer Affairs website](#) or request for one from Consumer Affairs. Businesses will need to fill out the general business application form and credit card remittance form if they choose to pay using a credit card. Business licences are valid for a fiscal year, from April 1 to March 31 of every year.

Collection agencies, vendors, and direct sellers may also submit licence applications. Please refer to the [Licence Fee Schedule](#) for applicable fees.
