Topic: **Capital & Repair Expenditures**
2020 (Intentions) and 2019 (Preliminary)
Released by Statistics Canada – February 27, 2020

Background: Capital expenditures in non-residential construction and machinery and equipment are expected to total **\$1.1 billion** in 2020, down **35.6%** from 2019.

1. The Capital and Repair Expenditures Survey is based on a sample survey of 25,000 private and public organizations. The preliminary estimates for 2019 and intentions for 2020 survey was conducted from September 2019 to January 2020.
2. The survey includes intentions for 2020, preliminary estimates for 2019 and revised estimates for 2018.
