**Topic:** **Capital & Repair Expenditures**  
2021 (Intentions) and 2020 (Preliminary)  
Released by Statistics Canada – February 26, 2021

**Background:** Capital expenditures in non-residential construction and machinery and equipment are expected to total **\$1.1 billion** in 2021, up **0.8%** from 2020.
