**COMMUNITY RESTRICTIONS REVOCATION ORDER (#2)**

**Hamlet of Rankin Inlet**

WHEREAS:

- A. The Minister of Health has declared a Public Health Emergency in Nunavut effective March 20, 2020 to address the novel coronavirus COVID-19 pandemic, and may renew this declaration every fourteen (14) days for the duration of the Public Health Emergency;
- B. Pursuant to section 41(1) of the *Public Health Act*, the Chief Public Health Officer may take certain actions, including issuing directions or orders for the purposes of protecting the public health and preventing, remedying or mitigating the effects of the Public Health Emergency; and
- C. The Chief Public Health Officer is satisfied that it is no longer necessary to place additional restrictions on social distancing and gatherings and the operation of food service establishments and licensed premises within the Hamlet of Rankin Inlet in order to contain the spread of novel coronavirus COVID-19;

THEREFORE, the Chief Public Health Officer hereby orders the following:

- 1. The *Order Respecting Social Distancing and Gatherings* (#4) issued for the Hamlet of Rankin Inlet on June 3, 2021 is revoked.
- 2. The *Communicable Disease Order* (#2) issued to food service establishments and licensed premises in the Hamlet of Rankin Inlet on May 24, 2021 is revoked.
- 3. All other Orders continue to be in effect.

This order is effective at 12:01 am CDT (UTC-5:00) on Friday, June 25, 2021.
