COMMUNITY RESTRICTIONS REVOCATION ORDER

HAMLET OF WHALE COVE

WHEREAS:

- A. The Minister of Health has declared a Public Health Emergency in Nunavut effective March 20, 2020 to address the novel coronavirus COVID-19 pandemic, and may renew this declaration every fourteen (14) days for the duration of the Public Health Emergency;
- B. Pursuant to section 41(1) of the *Public Health Act*, the Chief Public Health Officer may take certain actions, including issuing directions or orders for the purposes of protecting the public health and preventing, remedying or mitigating the effects of the Public Health Emergency; and
- C. The Chief Public Health Officer is satisfied that it is no longer necessary to restrict gatherings and the operation of food service establishments within the Hamlet of Whale Cove in order to contain the spread of novel coronavirus COVID-19 in a manner that is more restrictive than the orders applicable to the rest of Nunavut;

THEREFORE, the Chief Public Health Officer hereby orders the following:

- 1. *Communicable Disease Order (#4)* issued to food service establishments operating in the Hamlet of Whale Cove on January 12, 2021 is rescinded.
- 2. *Community Gatherings Restriction Order (#5)* issued for the Hamlet of Whale Cove on January 12, 2021 is rescinded.
- 3. All other Orders continue to be in effect.

This order is effective at 12:01 am CT (UTC-6:00) Friday, February 5, 2021.
