Topic: **Consumer Price Index (2002=100.0)**
 April 2021
 Released by Statistics Canada – May 19, 2021

Background: In April 2021, consumers in Iqaluit paid **0.6%** more than in April 2020 for the goods and services included in the Consumer Price Index basket.

The Canadian Consumer Price Index increased by **3.4%** over the same period.
