**Topic:** **Consumer Price Index (2002=100.0)**  
 August 2020  
 Released by Statistics Canada – September 16, 2020

**Background:** In August 2020, consumers in Iqaluit paid **2.3%** less than in August 2019 for the goods and services included in the Consumer Price Index basket.

The Canadian Consumer Price Index increased by **0.1%** over the same period.
