**Topic:** **Consumer Price Index (2002=100.0)**  
 March 2021  
 Released by Statistics Canada – April 21, 2021

**Background:** In March 2021, consumers in Iqaluit paid **0.5%** less than in March 2020 for the goods and services included in the Consumer Price Index basket.

The Canadian Consumer Price Index increased by **2.2%** over the same period.
