Topic: **Consumer Price Index (2002=100.0)**
 October 2022
 Released by Statistics Canada –November 16, 2022

Background: In October 2022, consumers in Iqaluit paid **4.3%** more than in October 2021 for the goods and services included in the Consumer Price Index basket.

The Canadian Consumer Price Index increased by **6.9%** over the same period.
