**CONSOLIDATION OF  
CORAL HARBOUR LIQUOR PROHIBITION REGULATIONS**

R.R.N.W.T. 1990, c.L-19

# Liquor Act (Nunavut)

## Coral Harbour Liquor Prohibition Regulations

### Prohibited Area

- 1** The Hamlet of Coral Harbour is declared a prohibited area.
- 2** No person shall purchase, sell, transport or possess liquor within the prohibited area described in section 1.

### Penalty

- 3** Every person who violates any provision of these regulations is guilty of an offence and liable on summary conviction to a fine not exceeding \$500 or to imprisonment for a term not exceeding 30 days or to both.
