Nunavut-Wide (excluding Coral Harbour and Pond Inlet)

Location	Maximum amount of people
Indoor gatherings, in a home	15 plus household
Indoor gatherings, non-dwellings	15
Indoor gatherings, group counselling	20
Indoor gatherings, halls, conference spaces, government and Inuit organization facilities	100 or 75% capacity*
Outdoor gatherings	100
Restaurants	75% capacity
Bars	75% capacity
Theatres	100 or 75% capacity*
Gyms/fitness centres/pools	25 or 50% capacity**
Libraries/museums/galleries	25 or 50% capacity*
Arenas	50 or 50% capacity*, plus maximum of 50 spectators
Places of worship	100 or 75% capacity*
Hairdressers/beauty salons	Open

*Whichever is less.

**Must have 2m between tables and between people in line, max. 6 people per table.

***Whichever is less, 25 people for group classes.

Location/condition	Conditions to follow
Schools	Open
Daycares	Open
Gatherings in public	Physical distancing of 2m
All businesses and organizations	Physical distancing of 2m
Masks	Mandatory
Taxis	Multiple fares if first passenger consents and all wear masks
Long term care facilities, continuing care facilities, boarding homes	Max 2 visitor per resident, immediate family only, masks mandatory

Nunavut Arctic College, grocery stores, pharmacies, fuel/motor vehicle service stations, post offices, banks, cleaning businesses, food banks, shelters, dental clinics, vet clinics, psychologists, massage therapists, chiropractors, parks, playgrounds, and health centres may open.
