Nunavut Secondary School Graduation Requirements

The Minister of Education has approved a change to the current Nunavut secondary school graduation requirements effective at the start of the 2014-2015 school year for all students entering Grade 10. There are two changes from the previous Graduation Requirements:

- 1. The required number of credits for Physical Education will be increased from 3 to 5 credits, to be completed at any grade level (10-12) but adhering to the course pre-requisite sequence;
- The required number of credits for Aulajaaqtut is reduced from 15 to 10, by removing the mandatory Aulajaaqtut 12 graduation requirement.
