Topic: Births
2011
Released by Statistics Canada – March 19, 2013

Background: In 2011, the number of births in Nunavut was **837**. This is an **increase** of **9** babies or **1.1%** from 2010.

For Canada, there were **423** more births or an increase of **0.1%** from the previous year.
