

Persons Disqualified

You will not be eligible to be a candidate for an AEC if you are:

- a judge of any court, other than a citizenship court;
- a Member of the Legislative Assembly (MLA) or a Member of Parliament;
- an election officer;
- in prison;
- convicted under any Canadian election act within the past 5 years; or
- found by a court to not be able to make decisions for yourself.

Basic duties and responsibilities

If elected, you will have a personal responsibility to fulfill the obligations of the office with impartiality and integrity to the best of your ability.

Elected AEC members have the duty to work towards promoting alcohol awareness, and regulating the purchase, sale and import of alcohol in your community. AEC responsibilities include, but are not limited to:

- be informed about alcohol issues in your community;
- understand the liquor restriction system in your community; and
- maintain fairness and declare conflict of interest where decisions may be viewed as supporting personal interests.

Help promote alcohol awareness in your community! Be a candidate!

Applications for AEC candidates are accepted from **September 23 to September 27 at 2 p.m. local time.**
