***PUBLIC HEALTH ACT, S. Nu. 2016, c. 13***

**REGIONAL RESTRICTIONS REVOCATION ORDER**

**KIVALLIQ REGION**

WHEREAS:

- A. The Minister of Health has declared a Public Health Emergency in Nunavut effective March 20, 2020 to address the novel coronavirus COVID-19 pandemic, and may renew this declaration every fourteen (14) days for the duration of the Public Health Emergency;
- B. Pursuant to section 41(1) of the *Public Health Act*, the Chief Public Health Officer may take certain actions, including issuing directions or orders for the purposes of protecting the public health and preventing, remedying or mitigating the effects of the Public Health Emergency; and
- C. The Chief Public Health Officer is satisfied that additional restrictions for social distancing, gatherings, food services, and licensed premises within the communities in the Kivalliq Region except the Hamlet of Arviat are no longer required in order to contain the spread of novel coronavirus COVID-19;

THEREFORE, the Chief Public Health Officer hereby orders the following:

- 1. The Kivalliq Region Gatherings Restriction Order (#1) issued March 1, 2021 is revoked.
- 2. The Communicable Disease Order (#1) issued to all food service establishments in the Kivalliq Region except the Hamlet of Arviat and to licensed premises in the Hamlets of Baker Lake and Rankin Inlet issued March 1, 2021 is revoked.
- 3. All other Orders continue to be in effect.

This order is effective at 12:01 am CDT (UTC-5:00) Wednesday, April 7, 2021.
