**CONSOLIDATION OF  
PELLY BAY [KUGAARUK] LIQUOR PROHIBITION REGULATIONS**

R.R.N.W.T. 1990, c.L-41

# Liquor Act (Nunavut)

## Pelly Bay Liquor Prohibition Regulations

### Prohibited Area

**1** All that portion of the Territories that lies within a radius of 25 km of the building in the Hamlet of Pelly Bay commonly known as the Hamlet Office is declared to be a prohibited area.

### Prohibition

**2** Subject to section 3, no person shall purchase, sell, transport or possess liquor within the prohibited area described in section 1.

**3(1)** A person who is employed in the operation of the DEW Line Site named “CAM 4”, located within the prohibited area, may purchase and possess liquor on that site if

(a) he or she is not resident in the prohibited area, or

(b) he or she is resident in the prohibited area by reason only of carrying out such employment.

(2) Sales on the “CAM 4” site that are incidental to purchases made under subsection (1) are exempted from the provisions of section 2.

(3) Transportation to the “CAM 4” site that is necessary for enabling purchases to be made under subsection (1) is exempted from the provisions of section 2.

### Penalty

**4** Every person who violates section 2 is guilty of an offence and liable on summary conviction to a fine not exceeding \$500 or to imprisonment for a term not exceeding 30 days or to both.
