
Backgrounder

This month, the Government of Canada delivered the first of two annual \$7.8 million federal Gas Tax Fund (GTF) installments to Nunavut. In total, the Territory will be provided over \$15.7 million this year through the fund. The funding, which flows through the territorial government, is now available to support community infrastructure projects.

The following table indicates this year's federal Gas Tax Fund allocation for Nunavut's communities.

Location	Federal Funding
Government of Nunavut	\$13,387,000
City of Iqaluit*	\$2,362,500

*The City of Iqaluit receives 15 per cent of the total funds allocated to Nunavut annually under an ultimate recipient agreement with Nunavut.
