To mark the end of Uqausirmut Quviasuutiqarniq, the Department of Culture and Heritage is launching the 2015 Qilaut compilation album. Qilaut is Nunavut's new annual Inuktut songwriting contest.

On February 24, 2016, people are invited to the Francophone Centre in Iqaluit for the launch and concert, where artists will perform all the winning songs. There will be two concerts – one from 2-4 p.m., and one from 7-9 p.m.
