Boil Water Advisory for Gjoa Haven

August 10, 2022 Gjoa Haven, Nunavut

The Department of Health is issuing a boil water advisory for the Hamlet of Gjoa Haven.

This is a precautionary measure due to inconsistent chlorine levels at the water treatment plant.

During a boil water advisory, all water for consumption must be brought to a rolling boil for a minimum of one full minute.

It is essential that all water be boiled for the following uses:

- Drinking.
- Preparing infant formulas.
- Preparing juices and ice cubes.
- Washing fruits and vegetables.
- Cooking.
- Brushing of teeth.

Water can be boiled either in a pot or kettle on a stove or an electric kettle without an automatic shut-off. It is not necessary to boil water used for anything other than the above list.

The Department of Health will notify the community when the boil water advisory is lifted.
