Queen Elizabeth II scholarship awards presented to top Nunavut nursing students

Iqaluit, Nunavut (May 2, 2023) – John Main, Minister of Health, presented five Queen Elizabeth II scholarship awards to top Nunavut Arctic College (NAC) nursing students at a luncheon in Iqaluit on Monday, April 24, 2023.

The Queen Elizabeth II scholarship awards are presented annually to the top students in their second, third and fourth years of the nursing program and include a \$3,000 scholarship to aid in their studies.

"As Nunavut continues to work through the challenges of a global nursing shortage, it is encouraging to know Nunavummiut are training to fill these much-needed roles," said Minister Main.
