## Simata Pitsiulak Aviation Scholarship

**Start Date:** July 17, 2023 **End Date:** August 31, 2023

Nunavut-wide 30 sec

Applications for the Simata Pitsiulak Aviation Scholarship are now open. If you are going to school to train as a pilot, aircraft maintainer, flight attendant, or studying airline or airport operations, you might be eligible. The scholarship is up to \$7,500 per student to help pay for education costs.

## Eligible applications must:

- Be currently enrolled in school to train as a pilot, aircraft maintainer, flight attendant, or in airline or airport operations.
- Be a Nunavut Inuk or a full-time resident of Nunavut (two-year minimum residency).
- Plan to work in Nunavut after finishing their education.

Full-time online courses and commercial flight time-building will be considered.
