***PUBLIC HEALTH ACT, S. Nu. 2016, c. 13***

**COMMUNITY GATHERINGS AND COMMUNICABLE DISEASE RESTRICTIONS  
REVOCATION ORDER**

**POND INLET AND IQALUIT**

WHEREAS:

- A. The Minister of Health has declared a Public Health Emergency in Nunavut effective March 20, 2020 to address the novel coronavirus COVID-19 pandemic, and may renew this declaration every fourteen (14) days for the duration of the Public Health Emergency;
- B. Pursuant to section 41(1) of the *Public Health Act*, the Chief Public Health Officer may take certain actions, including issuing directions or orders for the purposes of protecting the public health and preventing, remedying or mitigating the effects of the Public Health Emergency;
- C. The *Order Respecting Nunavut Impact Review Board Public Hearings* was effective April 12, 2021; and
- D. The Chief Public Health Officer confirmed a positive case of COVID-19 in Iqaluit, NU, on April 14, 2021:

THEREFORE, the Chief Public Health Officer hereby orders that the *Order Respecting Nunavut Impact Review Board Public Hearings* is hereby rescinded.

This order is effective at **7:00 am EST (UTC-11:00) on Thursday, April 15, 2021.**
