Topic: **Canada's Population Estimates**
 First Quarter 2018 (preliminary)
 Released by Statistics Canada – June 14, 2018

Background: Statistics Canada estimated Nunavut's population to be **38,456** as of April 1, 2018 – an increase of **0.7%** or **253** people from January 1, 2018.

By comparison, the population of Canada increased by **0.3%** over the same period.
