Released by Statistics Canada – June 18, 2020

Background: Statistics Canada estimated Nunavut's population to be **39,486** as of

April 1, 2010 – an increase of **1.0%** or **389** people from January 1, 2020.

By comparison, the population of Canada increased by 0.2% over the

same period.
