**Topic:** **Canada's Population Estimates**  
Fourth Quarter 2018 (preliminary)  
Released by Statistics Canada – March 21, 2019

**Background:** Statistics Canada estimated Nunavut's population to be **38,787** as of January 2019 – an increase of **0.4%** or **137** people from October 1, 2018.

By comparison, the population of Canada increased by **0.2%** over the same period.

- The estimates released today are based on 2016 Census counts adjusted for census net undercoverage and incompletely enumerated Indian reserves, to which are added the population growth estimates for the period from May 10, 2016, to the date estimate.
