Remaining vigilant and prepared

Nunavummiut's role in our path forward will continue to be vital. Staying vigilant will be essential to reduce the risks of COVID-19:

- Stay informed and follow public health advice.
- Get the vaccine. Vaccination is the most effective tool to prevent COVID-19.
- Practise good hygiene, even after the PHE is over. We have seen how simple things can reduce the risk for respiratory diseases. This means:
 - hand hygiene,
 - wear a mask when appropriate,
 - avoid touching your face,
 - stay home when sick, and
 - practise respiratory etiquette.

As Nunavut transitions away from a PHE managed by public health restrictions, the choices and actions of all Nunavummiut will decide the territory's future in the context of COVID-19.
