**Topic:** Public and Private Elementary and Secondary Education Expenditures  
2015/2016  
Released by Statistics Canada – October 23, 2018

**Background:** In Nunavut, a total of **\$150 million** was spent on Elementary and Secondary Education in 2015/2016 – up by **1.3%** from 2014/2015.
