



- Taxis can have multiple fares if first customer consents and everyone wears a mask. Masks mandatory upon request.

Licensed practitioners and personal service providers

- Veterinary practitioners and psychologists may open.
- Group counselling and support groups are restricted to 20 people.
- Personal service providers such as chiropractors, hairdressers, massage therapists can open but must use PPE upon request.

Long term care, continuing care and medical boarding homes

- Long term care facilities, continuing care centres and medical boarding homes can have a maximum of two visitors from their immediate family, masks are mandatory for visitors over the age of 4.

Recreation, leisure and community groups

- Public swimming pools, recreation centres and gyms open to solo workouts and lane swim only. Hot tubs and saunas may open. Maximum 10 people.
- Theatres open to 50 people or 50% capacity.
- Libraries, galleries and museums open to a maximum of 25 people or 50% capacity, whichever is less. Tours restricted to 10 people.
- Places of worship open to 50 people or 50% capacity.
- All public playgrounds, municipal parks, territorial parks, and territorial park - reserves may open, but buildings must be closed.
- Arenas are open at 50% capacity or 50 people; maximum spectator occupancy is 50.

NOTE: Arviat's current public health measures, including schools remain unchanged.
