Topic: Elementary-Secondary Education Survey for Canada, the Provinces and Territories
2016/2017
Released by Statistics Canada – November 2, 2018

Background: In the 2016/2017 school year, there were **291** students graduates in Nunavut public schools, an **increase of 39** or **15.5%** from the 2015/2016 school year.
