Prospecting

Nunavut Prospectors Program

The minerals and petroleum resources division of the Department of Economic Development and Transportation administers the Nunavut Prospectors Program.

The program provides financial contributions to eligible applicants for prospecting activities. It encourages Nunavummiut to become independent prospectors and entrepreneurs, often using and enhancing their knowledge of the land. You may apply for new funding each year.

Who can participate?

To participate you must:

- » be a Nunavut resident
- » be 18 years of age or older
- » hold a valid Prospecting Licence
- » have prospecting training or experience

What experience do you require?

You need to show you already have prospecting skills, or that you have completed the introductory prospecting course. The minerals and petroleum resources division offers the course. So far about 900 people have completed it.

You may apply for a contribution of up to \$8,000 per year to help pay for basic prospecting costs like consulting fees, vehicle maintenance, food while on the land, assistant's wages, prospecting supplies and mineral assay costs.

When to apply

The deadline for applications is **April 30** for prospecting work in the coming summer. You should apply early for initial review.
