Notice to all owners of Boiler or Pressure Vessels

The fees listed on the attached invoice are not inspection fees. This fee is an annual registration fee, as required to be collected yearly under the *Nunavut Boilers and Pressure Vessel Act and Regulations*. All jurisdictions in Canada collect a similar fee to cover the costs of maintaining a current file on all devices in service within the Territory.

In most cases Safety Section inspectors undertake to do an inspection on all Boilers or Pressure Vessels each year, yet it is not a requirement under the ACT.

When a building in which a registered device is located is sold, the new owner is to apply to Safety Section for new Certificates of Registration. There is a fee for changing the ownership of a Boiler or Pressure Vessels and issuing the Certificate of Registration.

Before a new Boiler or Pressure Vessel is installed an installation permit must be taken out. Further permission to operate the boiler must be given by the Boiler Inspector before any device may be placed in service. Failure to obtain a permit or receive permission to operate may result in the boiler being shut down until all the requirements of the ACT have been met.

When a Boiler or Pressure Vessel is removed from service the Certificate of Registration is to be returned to Safety Section. Notification must also be given as to the manner of disposal of the device. Failure to return the Certificates of Registration will result in the annual fee being invoiced to the listed owner until such time as the Certificate is returned.
