**Topic:** Wholesale Trade  
February 2021<sup>1</sup>  
Released by Statistics Canada – April 16, 2021

**Background:** The preliminary wholesale trade estimates for Nunavut for February 2021 were **\$7,685,000**, an **increase** of **4.2%** from February 2020.

By comparison, wholesale trade estimates for Canada **increased** by **4.2%** over the same period.

Readers should also be aware that the percentage change figures for Nunavut are a reflection of the relatively small volumes of retail sales. If they were to continue to increase over a number of reporting periods and /or remain at a higher level, that would be an indication of increased economic activity.
