Topic: Wholesale Trade
July 2021¹
Released by Statistics Canada –September 16, 2021

Background: The preliminary wholesale trade estimates for Nunavut for July 2021 were **\$32,577,000**, an **increase of 63.8%** from July 2020.

By comparison, wholesale trade estimates for Canada **increased by 5.6%** over the same period.

Please note that the percentage changes are calculated using unrounded sales figures. Readers should also be aware that the percentage change figures for Nunavut are a reflection of the relatively small volumes of retail sales. If they were to continue to increase over a number of reporting periods and /or remain at a higher level, that would be an indication of increased economic activity.
