



Reporting Zoonotic Diseases in Animals

REPORT AS SOON AS SUSPECTED BY TELEPHONE

- Suspected or confirmed rabies in animal
- Human contact with an animal known or suspected of having rabies
- Any other animal that may have been in contact with an animal known or suspected to have rabies

REPORT NEXT BUSINESS DAY VIA TELEPHONE, FAX or EMAIL

- Anthrax *Bacillus anthracis*
- Brucellosis *Brucella species*
- Erysipeloid *Erysipelothrix rhusiopathiae*
- Trichinellosis *Trichinella spiralis or nativa*
- Tuberculosis *Mycobacterium bovis or Mycobacterium tuberculosis*
- Tularemia *Francisella tularensis*
